### **Call to Worship - Psalm 27**

In the middle of trials and turmoil in our lives, Psalm 27 invites us to turn to look to Christ, let him lead us, and trust in His sovereign care. Read the underlined portions together.

One thing I have asked of the LORD;  
this is what I desire:  
to dwell in the house of the LORD  
all the days of my life,  
to gaze on the beauty of the LORD  
and seek Him in His temple.

## **Confession - Ephesians 3:14-19**

For some, entering a time of confession can be trite, even boring. For others, it may be a time that is uncomfortable because of how vulnerable it can be. Let's all be reminded that no matter the circumstances, or state of mind, Christ invites us to take these moments and be raw and real with Him. Let's speak this confession together:

We confess, that so often we bend our knees to our own will.  
We attempt to strengthen ourselves with our own power.  
We let worldly passions and desires dwell in our hearts.

Now take a moment to reflect on our complete dependence on the Son.

Church, hear Paul's prayer for the church in Ephesus:

"for this reason I bow my knees before the Father, from whom every family in heaven and on earth derives its name. I ask that out of the riches of His glory He may strengthen you with power through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith. Then you, being rooted and grounded in love, will have power, together with all the saints, to comprehend the length and width and height and depth of the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God." Ephesians 3:14-19

Because of Christ, we no longer stand condemned for our fleshly desire for independence. Instead, may we see our dependence upon Him as a gift. In His upside down kingdom, God does His best with empty.
