Genesis 12-25: Blessed to Be a Blessing

Call to Worship - Psalm 136:1-3, 23-24

Good morning and welcome to Antioch. Hear the word of the Lord from Psalm 136 and say the underlined portions with me:

Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good,

Congregation: for his steadfast love endures forever.

Give thanks to the God of gods,

Congregation: for his steadfast love endures forever.

Give thanks to the Lord of lords,

Congregation: for his steadfast love endures forever;

It is he who remembered us in our low estate,

Congregation: for his steadfast love endures forever;

and rescued us from our foes,

Congregation: for his steadfast love endures forever

We just can't say it enough—God's covenant loyalty, his steadfast love for his people never ends. That is our call to worship today, not that we love him, but that he loves us and welcomes us to respond to his love.
