Genesis 12-25: Blessed to Be a Blessing

Call to Worship - Isaiah 43:1-3

Good morning and welcome to Antioch, both those of you here in person and those joining us by livestream. My name is Brad and I'm one of the pastors here. Just a reminder, as a safety precaution please wear your mask when singing or when moving about the building, though you can remove it once seated. Also the nursing mother's area is just across the hall and the nursery is also open for wiggly kids.

Well this is the time in our gathering for our Call to Worship. And true to 2020, we desperately need it as this week alone we've waded through another high profile shooting, a deadly hurricane, and politicians calling us to trust in an earthly kingdom. We are passing through troubled times, and we need an anchor to keep us from a shipwrecked faith.

So hear this word from Isaiah 43:

1 But now thus says the Lord, he who created you, O Jacob, he who formed you, O Israel: "Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by name, you are mine.

- 2 When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you;
- when you walk through fire you shall not be burned,

and the flame shall not consume you.

3 For I am the Lord your God, the Holy One of Israel, your Savior. (Isaiah 43:1-3)

Church, let's fix our eyes on Jesus and on his kingdom that cannot be shaken...

Confession - Psalm 51:9-17

Let's pray this confession from Psalm 51 together, as we turn to the Lord and ask Him to forgive our sins and renew our joy. Please read the underlined portions with me:

Hide your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.

Congregation: Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me.

Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.

Congregation: Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will return to you.

Congregation: Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, O God of my salvation, and my tongue will sing aloud of your righteousness.

O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. For you will not delight in sacrifice, or I would give it; you will not be pleased with a burnt offering.

Congregation: The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise.
