### Confession - 2 Peter 3:9

As we enter a time of confession, we are reminded by the Apostle Peter in 2 Peter 3:9 that the Lord is patient toward us, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. In our sermon today we will encounter a man living among the dead who his freed by the power of Jesus to walk in the light of forgiveness. Jesus offers that same promise to us today. Take a moment briefly to confess your sins and needs to Christ with confidence that he stands ready with the grace and power to receive us and renew us.

Let's confess the following prayer together, read the underlined portion aloud:

You alone can take away our sins.

Congregation:

Help us in faith to see you as a blessing and not a burden.

You are incomparable in majesty.

Irresistible in power.

Unequal in authority.

Congregation:

Teach us to cling to you in hope.

You who crush our enemies by the simple word of your power.
