## Confession - Deuteronomy 32:4-5

We continue reading of our heavenly Father in Deuteronomy 32:

"The Rock, his work is perfect, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness and without iniquity, just and upright is he.

But then Moses suddenly speaks of the sins that separate us from him:

They have dealt corruptly with him;

they are no longer his children because they are blemished;

they are a crooked and twisted generation.

Deuteronomy 32:4-5

Let's confess this together:

Almighty and most merciful Father, we have strayed from your ways like lost sheep. We have left undone those things which we ought to have done, and we have done those things which we ought not to have done; and apart from your grace, there is no health in us. O Lord, have mercy upon us. Restore all those who confess their faults, according to your promises in Christ Jesus our Lord. And grant, O most merciful Father, for his sake, that we may now live a godly, charitable, and quiet life, to the glory of your holy Name.
