Call to Worship - Isaiah 66:1-2

When we say church, we don't just mean our building. There is a sense that this building we're all sitting in is set apart for the glory of God. But He is not confined here.

Would you stand and read the underlined portions with me?

Thus says the Lord:
"Heaven is my throne,
and the earth is my footstool;
what is the house that you would build for me,
and what is the place of my rest?
All these things my hand has made,
and so all these things came to be,
declares the Lord.
Isaiah 66:1-2

As His people we set apart places to be with God intentionally, but that is for our benefit and our short memories. He is present with us today, not because of something special about these four walls, but because God has put his spirit and his presence with us, His people, the church. This morning, let's remind each other of God's dwelling with us in worship.

Praise the Lord

Confession - 1 Peter 2:4-5, 9-10

As a church, God builds us together: we as his body are made up of people of all ages, colors, income levels, nationalities. He is creating a set apart people for Himself with beautiful diversity. Peter describes us this way:

As you come to him, a living stone rejected by men but in the sight of God chosen and precious, you yourselves like living stones are being built up as a spiritual house, to be a holy priesthood, to offer spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. You are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own possession, that you may proclaim the excellencies of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. 1 Peter 2:4-5, 9

Can you feel the weightiness of God's calling for us? Sometimes it feels heavy: we face rejection from others, difficulties fitting together our differences, and frequently falling short of the ideal set out before us. Yet this is how God builds us up. Take a moment to reflect on how the Lord is building you up, and bring your struggles to him. [Pause]

Praise the Lord that He hears us and is faithful to bring good works to completion in us.

Now let's speak this to one another:

Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy. 1 Peter 2:10
