- 3) Worldliness is the lust for what we don't have and pride in what we do have. Where do you see worldliness in this chapter? In yourself? (in other words, in Lot's shoes, what would be hard for you to let go?)
- 4) Fear leads Lot's family back into corruption after being rescued. How have you battled fear, especially in 2020?
- 5) Application - Read Genesis 19:27-29. How does Abraham's intercession give us a glimmer of hope? How does it compel you to be an intercessor?
