Outline

- 1) When God comes through, joyfully obey his word - vv. 1-7

Questions

- 1) Icebreaker - When something big happens in your life, how do you like to celebrate?
- 2) Read Genesis 21:1-7. How did Abraham and Sarah respond to the big thing God did in their lives?
- 3) Read Genesis 21:8-14. Here Sarah and Abraham removed a threat to the way of faith. What are things in your life that cultivate unbelief in you rather than faith? (examples: entertainment, activities, books, topics, people)
- 4) Read Genesis 21:25-34. Here we see Abraham putting down roots. Where in your life has God come through in a special way, and you need to respond by putting down roots?
- 5) Read Hebrews 11:13-16. Especially in this election season, what does it look like for us to be both rooted on earth and also desiring a heavenly country?
