- 4) Read Luke 1:1-3. Why does it matter that Luke compiled a narrative for us instead of a list of facts? If needed, discuss these two statements:
  - a) If it was just the teachings of Jesus, then it would do you no good.
  - b) If it was just the teachings of Jesus, then there would be no hero.
- 5) Read Luke 1:4. Over the next year of this sermon series how do you want to grow in certainty? After sharing, pray these things for one another.
