Questions

- 1) Icebreaker When was a moment in your life that you gave in to a major temptation (think funny more than serious—we'll get to that stuff later)?
- 2) Context Read Luke 4:1-13. Luke makes a clear connection to Adam (3:38) right before Jesus enters temptation. Where do you see connections to Adam throughout this passage? Why does that matter?
- 3) What do you learn from Jesus in this passage about how to be victorious over temptation?
- 4) Application Split into groups of guys and girls. Take some time to share your temptations with one another. If needed, use the following prompts from the passage:
 - a) Where are you tempted to give in to sin because you feel like God is neglecting your needs? (4:1-4)
 - b) Where are you feeling like doing things God's way is too painful, and so you're tempted to do it your own way? (4:5-8)
 - c) Where are you tempted to say in your heart, "God, you didn't do ______, so I think you don't love me"? (4:9-13)
- 5) Prayer Read Hebrews 4:15-16. Pray this passage for one another.
