Title - God is Love

#### Questions

- 1) Icebreaker - Try to name something that if you showed it to everyone they would ask, "What is it?" (better yet, if you can find an object like that, literally show it to everyone)
- 2) Without the Bible, what are some of the ways humans tend to answer the question, "What is God?"
- 3) Read 1 John 4:7-12. What do you think John wants us to *learn* when he writes here, "God is love"?
- 4) Read 1 John 4:13-19.
  - a) What do you think John wants us to *feel* when he writes here, "God is love"? (Pastor Michael exemplified in the sermon that God's love shouldn't just move our minds but also our hearts)
  - b) One of the things we are *not* to feel is fear. How are your fears disconnecting you from God's love?
- 5) Pastor Michael said, "Our response to our God who *is* love is *to be* love to others." What could that look like, especially in such a fractured time?
