 - b) Like Laban, who has God put in your life that drives you nuts, but they're actually God's way of holding up a mirror to you?
- 4) Read Genesis 29:31-35. What do you learn from Leah here?

5) Application - Jesus wants to satisfy and redeem our deepest desires in the light of community. What desire do you need to bring into that light?
