- 2) Context - Read Acts 1:6-8. What does this conversation reveal about stories of the apostles? About Jesus' patience?
- 3) Read Acts 6:1-7. What does this teach us about majority-minority conflict in the church? (Facilitators: If needed, you can refer to the Outline above.)
- 4) Application - How is Jesus changing your story after these past three weeks?
