Questions

- 2) Read Ephesians 5:1-15. What's helpful about Paul's analogy of the Christian life as walking together?
- 3) Read Ephesians 5:15-17. In light of our current cultural context, why is it important to walk wisely and understand the will of the Lord?
- 4) Read Ephesians 5:18-21. What does this teach us about being filled with the Spirit?
- 5) Application - The passive voice of the command "be filled" doesn't call us to action, but to yielding (example: "be helped"). How do you need to yield to the Spirit?
