Main idea - When life gets interrupted, turn to Jesus.

Outline

Questions

- 1) Icebreaker - What is your typical reaction to an interruption?
- 2) Context - Read Luke 8:40. Instead of imploring him to leave, this crowd welcomes Jesus. What does Jesus' response to crowds teach us about him?
- 3) Read Luke 8:41-42. Why does it often take an emergency for us to implore Jesus?
- 4) Read Luke 8:43-48. How does Jesus turn this interruption into an opportunity?
- 5) Read Luke 8:49-56. What impacts you most from Jesus' interaction with this little girl?
- 6) Application - How do you see God using 2020 to help you trust Jesus more? (This might be a good opportunity to pray together, giving thanks for the good people mention and praying for people who are struggling to see any good.)
