- 3) Why is it that Christians can bear their souls to one another and the result is encouragement?
- 4) Read Ephesians 6:23-24. Of all the blessings Paul could have asked for, Paul chose peace, love, faith, and grace. Which one do you need to receive most right now? Why?
- 5) Application - If you were to write your own benediction (the words God would speak to you at the end of your life) what would it say?
