Main idea - When children walk away, turn to Jesus.

Outline

- 3) Receive God's love when they come back - vv. 25-32

Questions

- 1) Icebreaker - What comes to mind when you hear the word "prodigal"? (in other words "extravagantly wasteful")
- 2) Context - Read Luke 15:1-3. Why did Jesus tell the three "lost" parables? What do they have in common?
- 3) Read Luke 15:11-24. What did the younger son do that was so bad? How did the father respond?
- 4) Read Luke 15:25-32. What did the older son do that was just as bad as his brother? How did the father respond?
- 5) How do you see God reflected in this story?
- 6) Application - Where do you see yourself reflected in the story? How is God inviting you back home?
