Questions

- Reflect on the statistic mentioned in the sermon that 70% of students who were active in their church during their high school years, dropped out of church involvement between the ages of 18-22. - What were some of the contributing factors in your life that God used to keep you in the church during those pivotal years? If you had a season where you were not involved with the church, what were some of the contributing factors God used to call you back to the church?
- Read Proverbs 3:13-18. What are some of the reasons we should be motivated to seek after wisdom?
- Read Proverbs 3:19-20. What memories do you have of your parents teaching you wisdom's ways - what is the significance of this for you? In what way does creation proclaim the wisdom of God? Parents, how do you point out God's wisdom to your children in creation?
- Read Proverbs 3:21-26. We talked about how Jesus Christ is the embodiment and fulfillment of wisdom. How does this understanding help you apply the main point of the sermon to seek wisdom, learn its ways, and walk wisdom's path?
