Potential Discussion Questions

- There were a number of great questions that Josh asked throughout the sermon. The easiest way to minister the word to one another this week might be to simply read the passage and walk through his questions:
 - Where do you find yourself "putting Jesus to the test"? In what areas of your life is he not "living up to your standard"?
 - How do you seek to "justify yourself" before God and others? Where are you painting the picture of a "law-keeper" to distract from the fact that, deep down, you don't measure up?
 - How do you "pass by" the broken and vulnerable? Why do you pass by? How can you begin to heal so that you might have the courage to stop "on the Jericho Road"?
 - Who is your "Samaritan"? Who do you feel isn't worthy of God's love, and yours?
 - When you read this story, are you tempted to "get busy" without reflecting on God's mercy toward you? Or are you tempted to minimize the call for sacrifice and action?
