- 1) Shepherds—lead with the humility of Jesus - vv. 1-4
- 2) Sheep—be led with the humility of Jesus - v. 5

Potential Discussion Questions

- What did you think about the multicultural gathering? What blessed you? What was challenging for you?
- This week's sermon was short and simple, but sometimes that makes God's voice even clearer. Anything that significantly impacted you?
- Read 1 Peter 5:1-5. Why do you think Peter would include this section in a letter to people who were suffering and persecuted?
- What does this passage teach us about God and his church?
- Peter tells us to clothe ourselves with humility toward one another. What does that tangibly look like? Followup question: When we don't do this, we can become wolves toward one another. What does that tangibly look like?
- How do you need to grow in humility toward the shepherds or the sheep (ultimately toward the Chief Shepherd)? Pray for one another in these things.
