For everyone, here are a few ways to take the following steps:

- 1) Parents of Young Disciples we are planning to have an event for Young Disciples on Saturday, May 25, from approximately 2-4pm. More details will be available soon, but please hold that date and time!
- 2) Thanks to everyone who served in various ways this month to help pull off another successful food pantry. We served 76 families representing 280 individuals (we gave out 76 boxes because one household of African immigrants was especially large). Not only that, but we continue to see more and more of our visitors serving alongside our already multicongregational team on Fridays and Saturdays.

I want to share some evidence of God's grace in the form of answered prayers. I asked you in February and March to pray for grace and favor with Dare to Care against their anti-Gospel policy. Although their policy hasn't changed (and neither has our position [Acts 4:19-20] and certainly not the Lord Jesus Christ, who is the same yesterday, today, and forever [Heb 13:8]), Dare to Care has awarded us a \$6,628 grant to repair our walk-in refrigerator. This is on top of a \$2,000 grant we received from LRBA to purchase another freezer. He gives more grace!

We begin each gathering with a call to worship and end with a benediction, which is simply a reminder that we are blessed to be a blessing.
