0:00 Call to Worship - 1 Samuel 2:2-3, 8-10

Antioch is a church that's seeking to cultivate intentional gospel relationships. Because of that, we can come into a gathering like this with honesty about where we're at. Maybe like the story of Joseph that we'll read today, this morning when you were looking in the mirror getting ready, you were also preparing for others to see you in a certain light. But the God who sees you fully, invites you to come into his light.

This was a hard week. There were heavy things that happened in our nation, our denomination, and the life of our church. Maybe you are carrying the weight of some of those things, and all the commentary that goes around with them. But for the next few moments, let's choose to bring our hearts and to give our ears to the One whose voice matters most. Hear the word of the Lord from Hannah's prayer in 1 Samuel 2:

2 "There is no one holy like the Lord; there is no one besides you; there is no Rock like our God.3 "Do not keep talking so proudly or let your mouth speak such arrogance, for the Lord is a God who knows, and by him deeds are weighed.

Congregation: 8 He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the needy from the ash heap; he seats them with princes and has them inherit a throne of honor.

9 He will guard the feet of his faithful servants, but the wicked will be silenced in the place of darkness.
"It is not by strength that one prevails;
10 those who oppose the Lord will be broken.
The Most High will thunder from heaven;
the Lord will judge the ends of the earth.
"He will give strength to his king
and exalt the horn of his anointed." 1 Samuel 2:2-3, 8-10, NIV

Antioch is a church that's seeking to display Christ's glory. Therefore when we read that Pharaoh asked, "Can we find a discerning and wise man, in whom there is the Spirit of God?" we answer, "Yes, we know that guy!" In 1 John 4 we read,

By this you know the Spirit of God: every spirit that confesses that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is from God, 1 John 4:2

So let's make this our confession this morning, from the Nicene Creed:

We believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only Son of God, begotten from the Father before all ages, God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made; of the same essence as the Father. Through him all things were made. For us and for our salvation he came down from heaven; he became incarnate by the Holy Spirit and the virgin Mary, and was made human. He was crucified for us under Pontius Pilate; he suffered and was buried. The third day he rose again, according to the Scriptures. He ascended to heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again with glory to judge the living and the dead. His kingdom will never end.
