0:00 Call to Worship - Psalm 89:1-2, 5

I don't know what season you're a fan of—some people love Fall and some people hate it. But there is something about the beauty of all the leaves turning different colors. It speaks to us that there is something more at play in our world than just time passing by. It awakens us to the reality that before the earth was made, there was a perfect Creator of the universe, who made all things and all things good. This Creator was committed to his good plans for his creation, and he has remained faithful to it to this day.

Hear this word in response to him from Psalm 89:

1 "I will sing of the steadfast love of the LORD, forever;
With my mouth I will make known your faithfulness to all generations.
2 For I said, "Steadfast love will be built up forever; In the heavens you will establish your faithfulness."
Psalm 89:1-2

On behalf of the Lord we welcome you today, whatever you bring and whatever you lack. Where you have been unfaithful to him this week, his steadfast love has remained. It is written in every color of the leaves. So let us respond along with the psalmist:

Let the heavens praise your wonders O LORD, Your faithfulness in the assembly of holy ones! Psalm 89:5

Church, in the sermon passage that we will hear today, Jesus calls us to sit down, count the cost, and consider if we are able to follow him as disciples. The temptation for us is to either follow naively without counting the cost, or to follow naively thinking we are able to do it all in our own strength. Both of these are dangerous, as the prophet Jeremiah warns us:

The heart is deceitful above all things, and desperately sick; who can understand it? Jeremiah 17:9

God understands it, and he invites us to a better vision for following Jesus, one that knows the cost, but depends fully on him to pay it. As a way of confessing our need, join in praying through the following liturgy (and say the underlined portions with me):

God, wake us to be present with you and to one another in these shared hours we are here. **For it is you, O Lord, who have So gathered us from our various places, And you alone who knows our hearts And our needs.**

O Father, enlarge our hearts. O Spirit, expand our vision. O Christ, establish your kingdom among us. **Be at work even now, O Lord, That we may be enabled and encouraged To follow you together.**
